



Penrith City Council's Local Celebration Awards program developed to recognise and celebrate the people who are making a difference in Penrith. It doesn't matter how big or small their act of kindness is or how young or old they are. This is your chance to nominate a friend, family member, community leader, colleague, group or organisation – any Australian who you believe makes Penrith a better place to live.

CATEGORIES

Citizen of the Year:

Awarded to the person who has contributed most significantly to the City of Penrith, demonstrating commitment, involvement in activities and innovation that has led to the betterment of the people within the Penrith community. The recipient needs to be a Penrith resident, aged 18 or over.

Young Citizen of the Year:

Awarded to a young person aged 24 years or younger, who has contributed most significantly to the City of Penrith over a number of years, providing outstanding community service and/or attaining outstanding achievement in academics, sport, arts, or charity work. The recipient needs to be a Penrith resident.

Mayor's Local Heroes Award:

Awarded to the person or persons who has contributed most significantly to the City of Penrith demonstrating commitment and involvement in activities that have led to the betterment of the people within the Penrith community. The recipient/s need to be a Penrith resident, there's no age limit.

Making A Difference - Community Service Award:

Awarded to the person or persons who have shown outstanding dedication and contribution to one or more areas that has led to the betterment of the quality of life of others in the City of Penrith community in areas such as volunteering, charitable work, supported the community during emergencies/natural disasters, championing environmental initiatives, made a contribution in the sporting arena, or provided exceptional community leadership. For this award the recipient/s does not need to reside in the Penrith Local Government Area. There is no age limit.



HOW TO PREPARE THE NOMINATION

Selection Criteria: The nominee will be assessed against the below criteria:

- Demonstrated contribution to the Penrith community
- A role model for the community
- Activities align with our core values of:

Can do attitude – a focus on getting the right things done

Harmony – valuing relationships – actively promoting collaboration and partnering to achieve more

Lifestyle – setting a new benchmark for a balanced, healthy and respectful lifestyle

Openness – embracing new ideas, new people to do things differently for our communities' benefit

Invention – looking for new and better ways of delivering services an community activities for greater participation and diversity

Transformation – driving real change in our city for the

CATEGORIES FOR SELECTION

All nominees aged 18 years and over will be considered for the Citizen of the Year award.

All nominees aged 24 years and younger will be considered for the Young Citizen of the Year Award

It is at the discretion of the judging panel to consider nominees for any of the award categories not necessarily the category they were nominated for.

ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST

Eligible nominations:

- Australian Permanent Resident of Australian Citizen
- Individual members of the public
- Local volunteer group, community groups, sporting groups or organisation (group of 6 members)
- Nominees must reside, work or have made a significant contribution in the City of Penrith.

Ineligible nominations:

- Current Penrith City Council employees
- Sitting local, state and federal politicians
- Self-nominees
- Awards will not be granted posthumously.

THE AWARD PROCESS

Penrith City Council calls on individuals, groups and organisations to nominate worthy recipients for the Penrith Local

During May 2024, nominations are collated and the Councillor selection panel selects the award recipients in each of the four award categories.

Award recipients are honoured: Award recipients will be announced at Council's July Ordinary Meeting and recognised at a formal event in August.
