### COUNCIL BRIEFS

- Did you know there are a few ways to access your COVID-19 vaccination proof? If you need support, try one of these options.

Each person's digital certificate can be downloaded online for free once they have are fully vaccinated, meaning they have received two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine.

Visit [servicesaustralia.gov.au/covid19](https://servicesaustralia.gov.au/covid19) and then scroll down and click on the 'COVID-19 vaccinations' information.

If you are unable to get your proof online, your vaccination provider can print out your immunisation history statement for you. This also serves as a form of proof.

Alternatively, you can request a printed copy of your certificate by calling the Australian Immunisation Register, open Monday to Friday from 8am–5pm, on 1800 653 809.

- Since adopting the green-lidded Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO) bin over two years ago, Penrith's rural communities have diverted 5,413,054kg from landfill, which is the equivalent of 722 FOGO truck loads!

By diverting FOGO organic waste such as food scraps and garden vegetation from landfill, you're minimising negative impacts on the environment and playing an important part in giving back. All that organic waste gets turned into compost which is used within the Penrith community — which is a much better use for it than going back into landfill.
